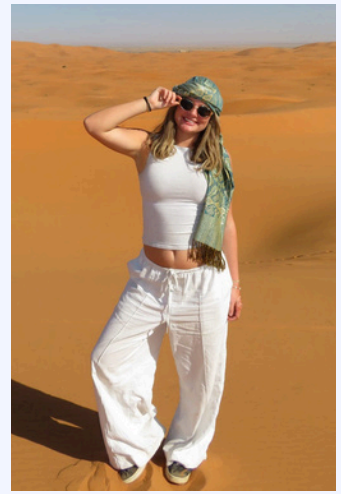
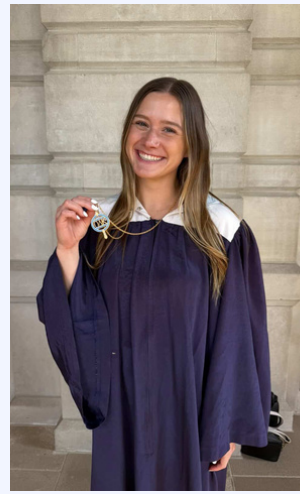


STORIES FROM OUR SISTERS
