SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES IN THE NATURAL SCIENCES, MATHEMATICS, AND ENGINEERING

The Goldwater Scholarship supports outstanding students interested in research careers in the natural sciences, mathematics, and engineering. **The scholarship covers undergraduate eligible expenses for tuition, fees, books, and room and board up to \$7,500 per academic year for up to 2 years.**

ELIGIBILITY

To be considered for nomination, a student must:

- Be a matriculated sophomore or junior pursuing a degree at an accredited 2- or 4-year U.S. institution of higher education and be a full-time matriculated student during the academic terms when receiving scholarship support from the Foundation.
- Intend to pursue a research career in science, mathematics, or engineering,
- Have a college grade point average of at least a 3.00 on a 4.00 scale, and
- Be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident.

NOMINATION PERIOD

First Tuesday in September through 5:00 p.m., CT on the last Friday in January.
